O.T.T. Simple Present

SIMPLE FORM

Grammar rule

stam

stam + s bij he, she, it

Example

I work in an office.

He works as a teacher.

CONTINUOUS

Grammar rule

am

are + werkwoord + ing

is

Example

I am reading a book now.

PASSIVE FORM

Grammar rule

am

are + voltooid deelwoord

is **stam+ed of 3^e rijtje**

Example

These albums are produced by JayLo.

Vorm van de tijden

O.V.T. Simple Past

SIMPLE FORM

Grammar rule:

Regelm: stam + ed

Onregel: 2e rijtje vd onr. ww.

Example

I worked in an office.

He taught English at school.

CONTINUOUS

Grammar rule

was

were + werkwoord + ing

Example

I was listening to the radio an hour ago.

PASSIVE FORM

Grammar rule

was

were + voltooid deelwoord

Example

The song was brought to you by radio
Veronica.

Vorm van de tijden

V.T.T. Perfect Present

SIMPLE FORM

Grammar rule:

have
has + voltooid deelwoord

Example

I have read the article.
He has seen that film twice already.

CONTINUOUS

Grammar rule

have
has + been + ww + ing

Example

They have been swimming for hours now.

PASSIVE FORM

Grammar rule

have
has + been + voltooid deelw.

Example

The record has been bought by millions.

Vorm van de tijden

V.V.T. Past Perfect

SIMPLE FORM

Grammar rule:

had + voltooid deelwoord

Example

She had finished her work when Tom entered the room.

CONTINUOUS

Grammar rule

had + been + ww + ing

Example

They had been watching TV when I asked them what they had been doing.

PASSIVE FORM

Grammar rule

had + been + voltooid deelwoord

Example

The house had already been broken into when I came home.

Vorm van de tijden

O.T.T.T. Future present

SIMPLE FORM

Grammar rule:

will + hele ww.

shall + hele ww.

(ALLEEN bij I en WE)

Example

I shall go to London next summer.
They will enter the contest just for the fun of it.

CONTINUOUS

Grammar rule

will/shall + be + ww + ing

Example

You will be studying this afternoon, so I will not call.

PASSIVE FORM

Grammar rule

will/shall + be + voltooid deelw.

Example

The party will be held at my place.

Vorm van de tijden

O.V.T.T. Future Past

SIMPLE FORM

Grammar rule:

would/should + hele ww.
(should ALLEEN bij I en WE)

Example

I would go if I knew it would help.

CONTINUOUS

Grammar rule

would/should + be + ww + ing

Example

He would be doing his homework if he knew he would get a test.

PASSIVE FORM

Grammar rule

would/should + be + volt. deelw.

Example

The president would be decorated if the senate could look into the future.

Vorm van de tijden

V.T.T.T. Future perfect

SIMPLE FORM

Grammar rule:

will/shall + have + volt. deelw.

Example

By the time you arrive here I shall have finished working.

CONTINUOUS

Grammar rule

will/shall + have + been + ww + ing

Example

In an hour they will have been watching television for four hours.

PASSIVE FORM

Grammar rule

will/shall + have + been + volt. deelw

Example

The concert will have been given.

Vorm van de tijden

V.V.T.T.

Future past perfect

SIMPLE FORM

Grammar rule:

would/should + have + v. deelw.

Example

They would have seen the picture if they had stayed home.

CONTINUOUS

Grammar rule

would/should + have + been + ww + ing

Example

They would have been doing their homework but I told them to go to town.

PASSIVE FORM

Grammar rule

would/should + have + been + volt. deelwoord

Example

Free tickets would have been given if they had been available.
