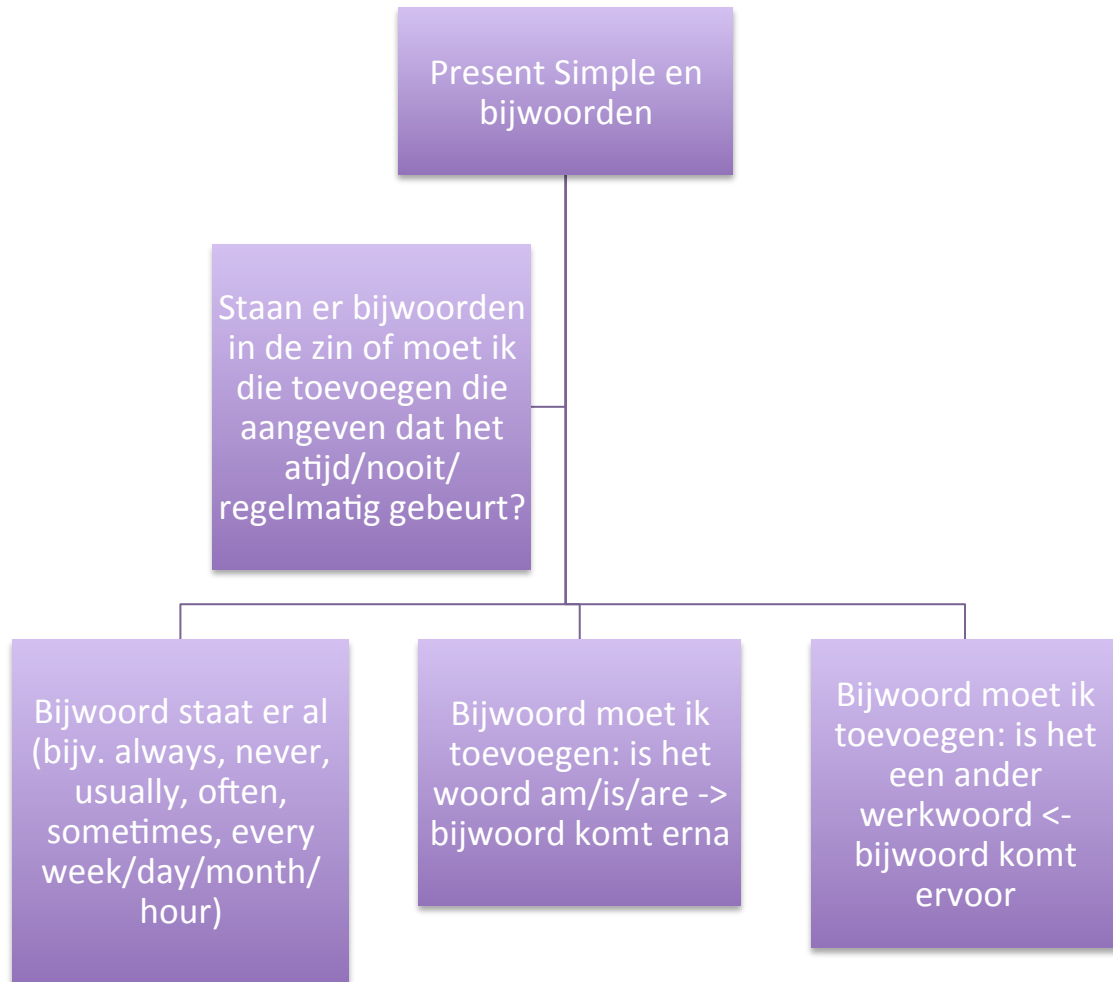


Present Simple zin: *I always walk to school.* (algemeen, vaste gebeurtenis)

Present Continuous zin: *I am walking to school right now.* (op dit moment)





Voorbeelden:

I often go to school by bus.

You don't often go to school by bus.

I am never late to our meetings.

We sometimes write poems.

You never do anything!

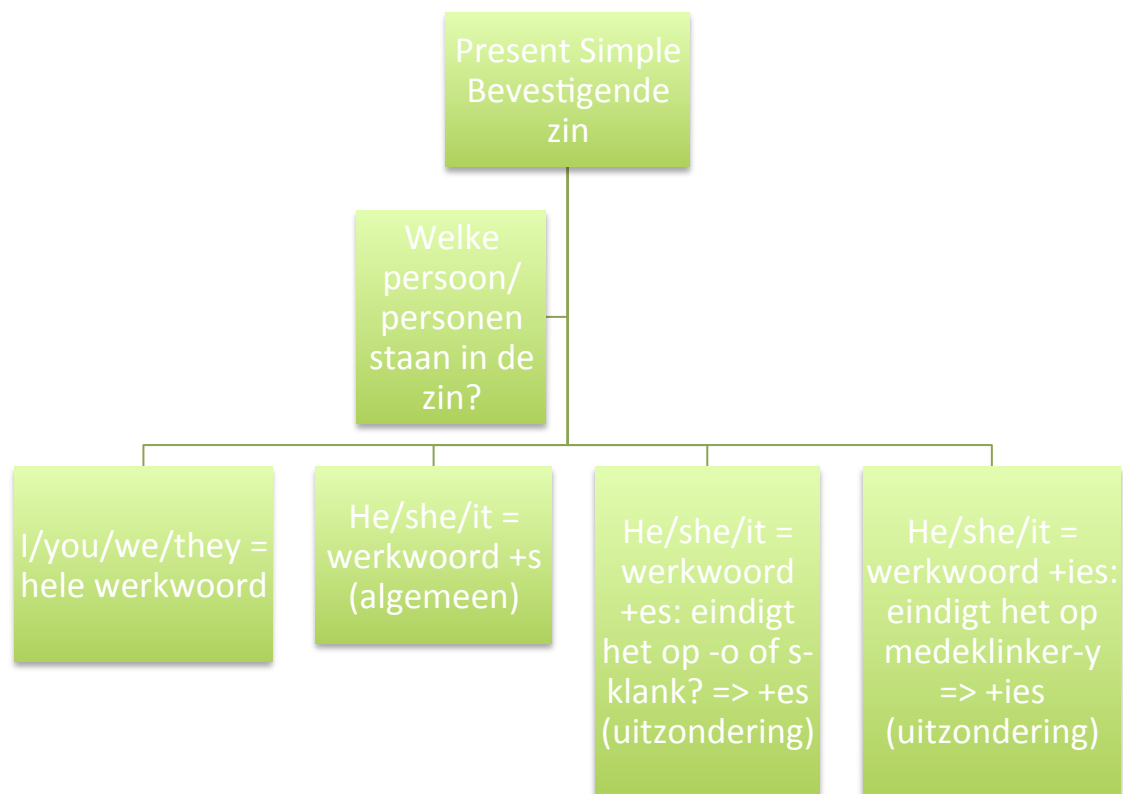
They are usually on time.

Donny is always complaining.

Mrs Khan isn't usually this strict.

Do you always have a coffee in the morning?

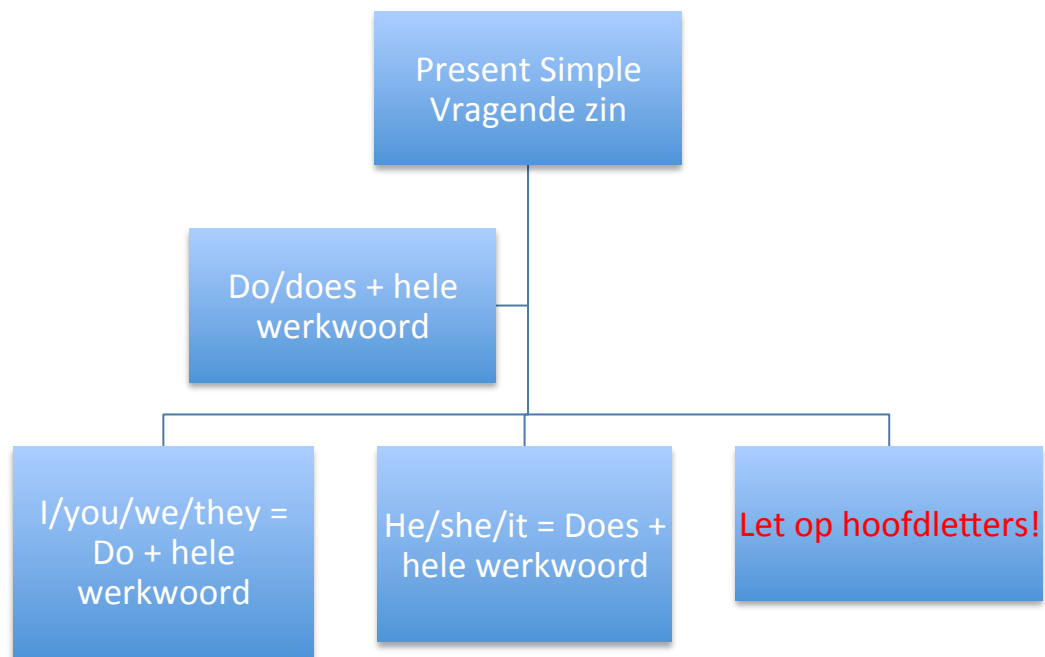
Does Sharon never buy clothes on sale?



Voorbeelden:

*I walk to school every day.
You talk to your mother before bed.
We have breakfast at 10 o'clock on Saturdays.
They start the game with a whistle.
Donny and Jess sometimes play chess.*

*He plays soccer on the weekend.
She does her homework when she is home.
The airplane leaves the station in 5 minutes.
Donny watches tv at night.
Mrs Khan passes the papers around.
Jess studies her words 3 times a week.*



Voorbeelden:

Do I have your word on that?

Do you promise me?

Do we need that?

Do they call their teacher Mrs Khan?

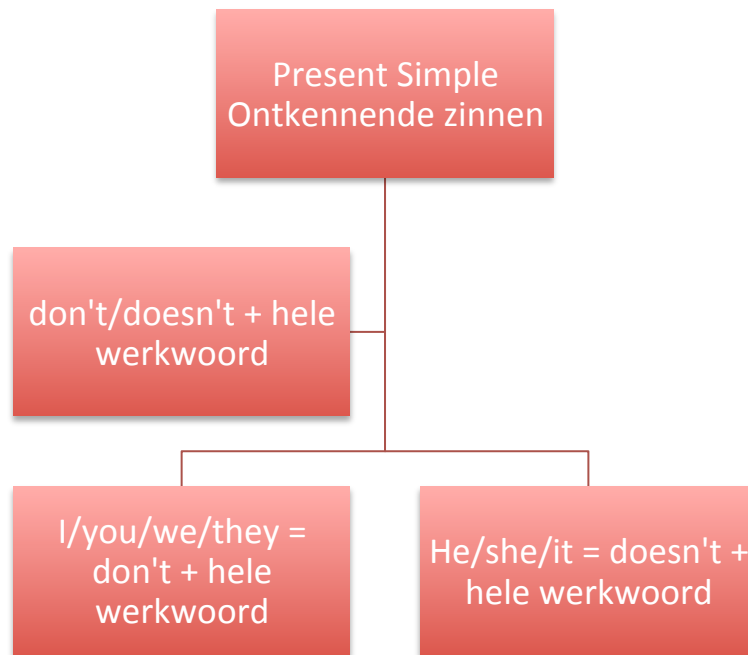
Does he know what he has?

Does she write for the school's paper?

Does it hurt?

Does Jess walk to school?

Does Donny like Jess?

I don't like that

You don't have time for that.

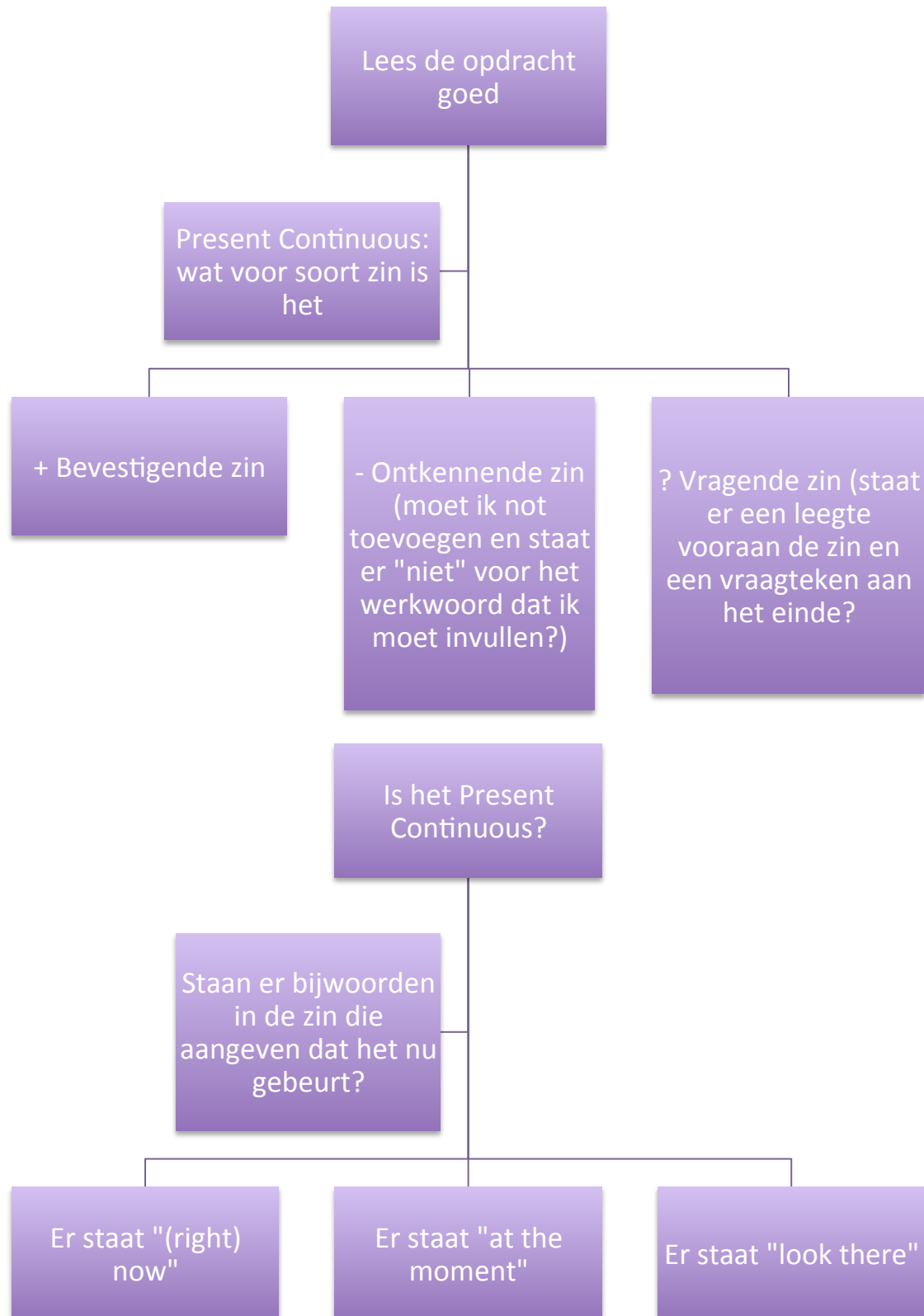
We don't think that is the best option.

Cry -> crying

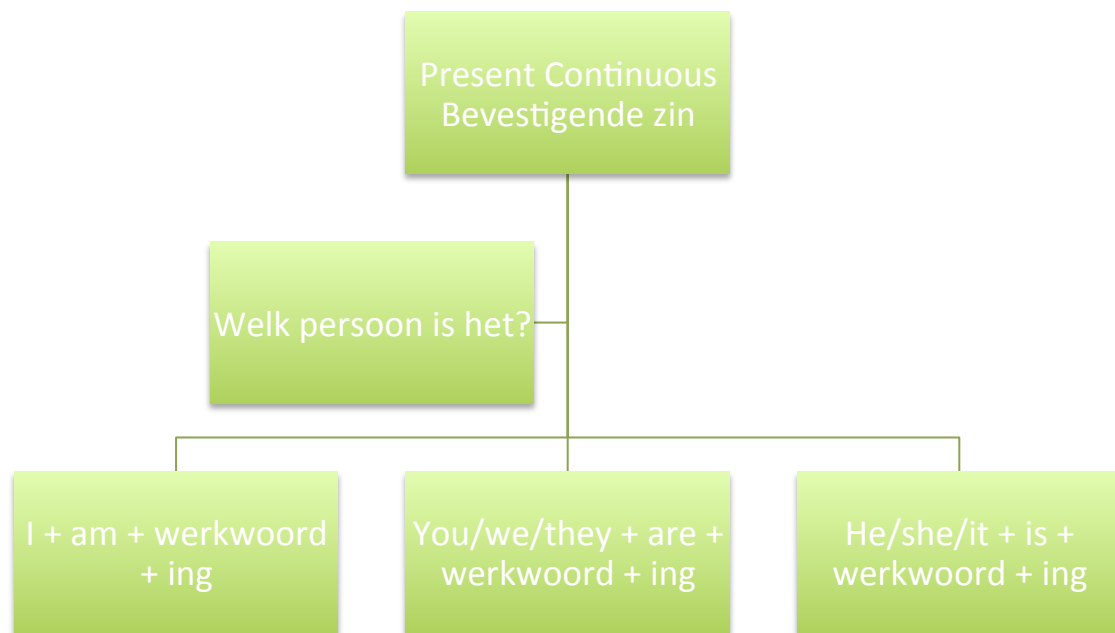
Op klinker-medeklinker met een lettergreep

Are you staying here?

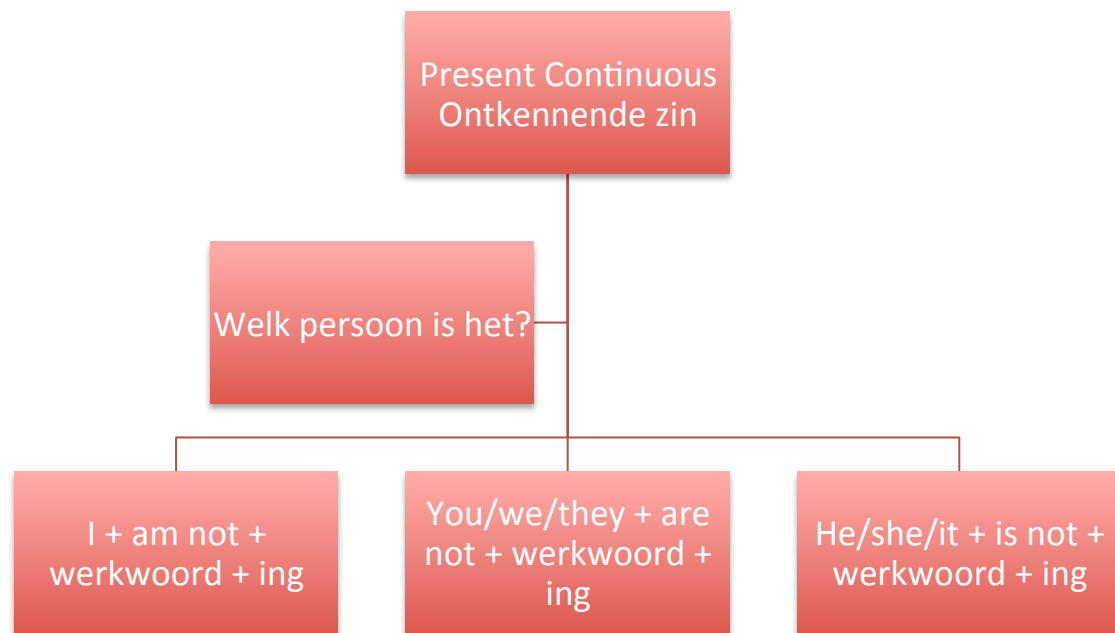
Are we going to the party?

You're not having icecream before dinner.

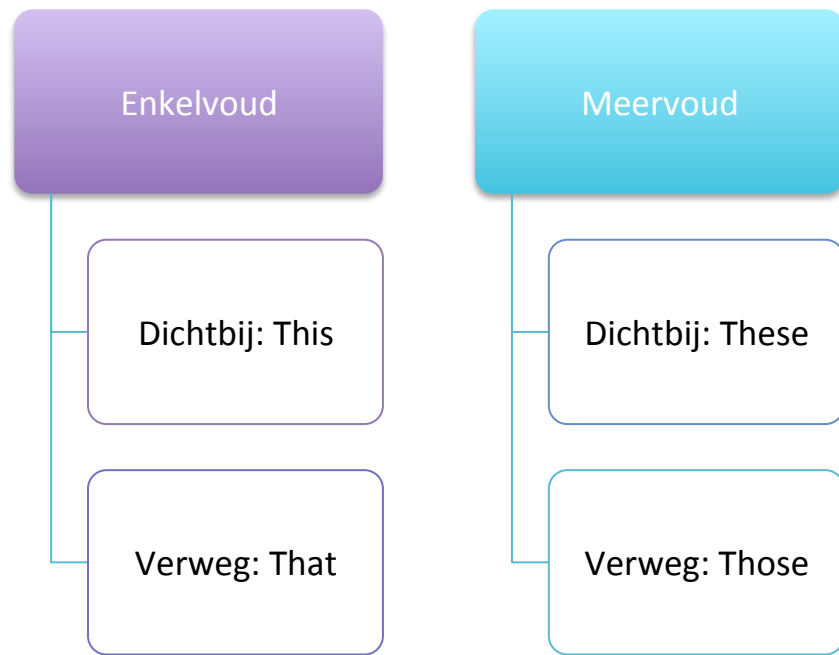
We're not doing that dance.

It isn't raining now.



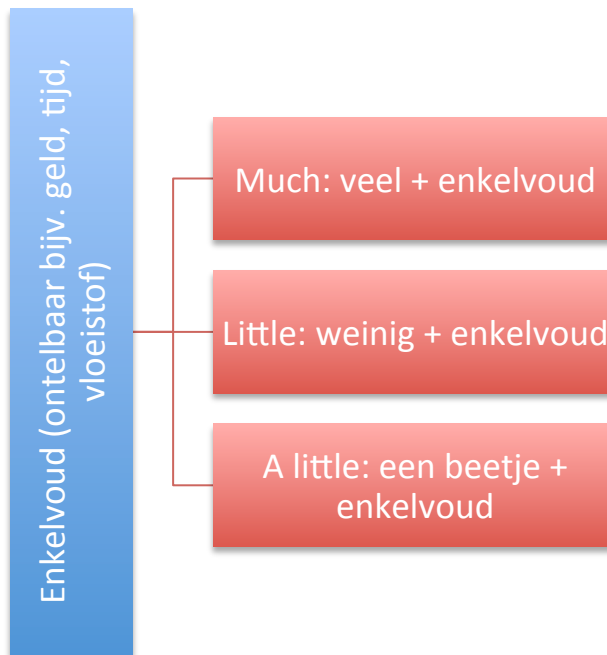
Voorbeelden:

Those flowers over there.

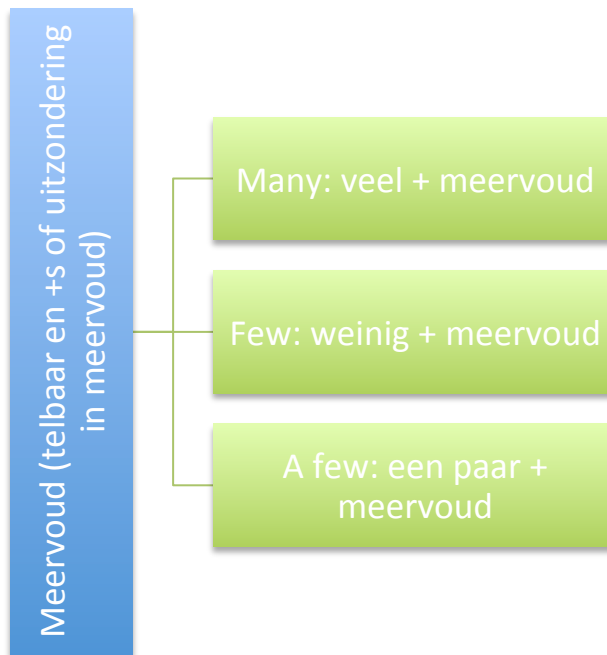


Voorbeelden:

It looks like it rains, doesn't it?

Eerst ontkennend, tag bevestigend

I'm not hungry, am I?

You're not very excited, are you?

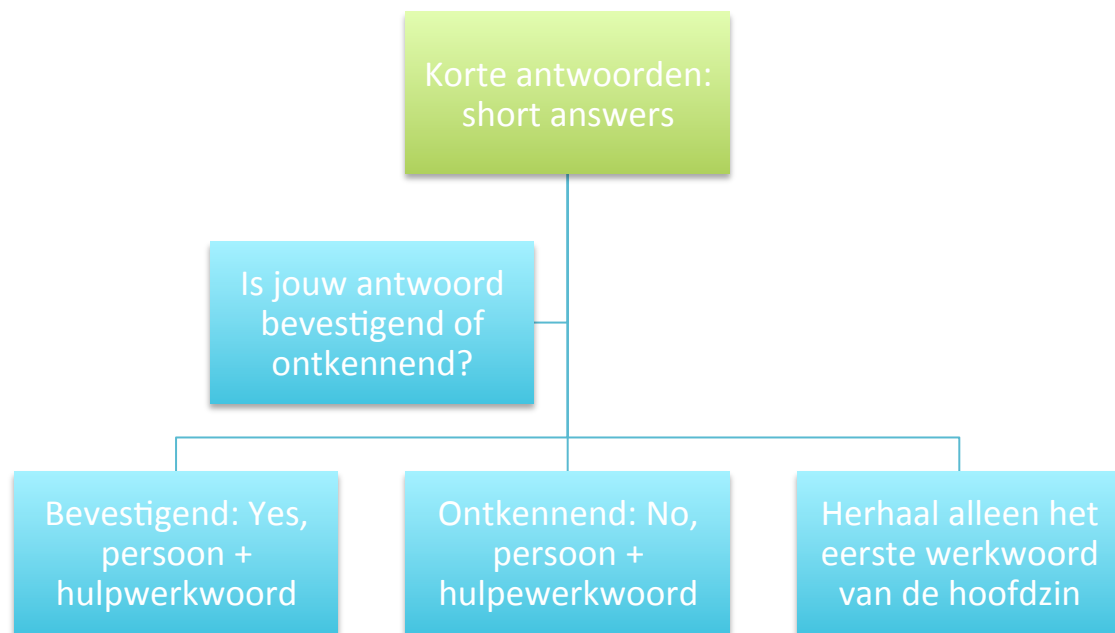
We don't expect a lot, do we?
