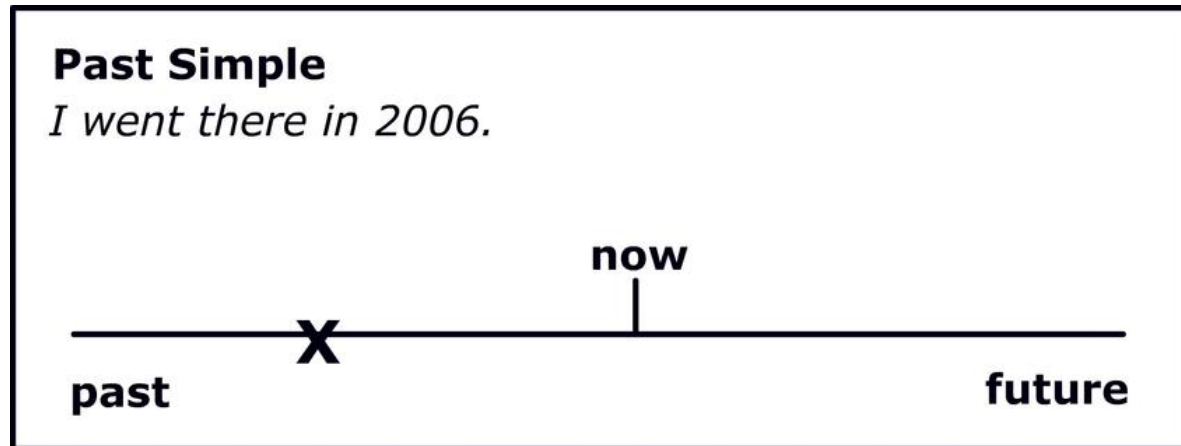


# GRAMMAR – PAST SIMPLE

- In verleden gebeurd en afgelopen
- Vaak tijdsbepaling (last summer, two years ago...)



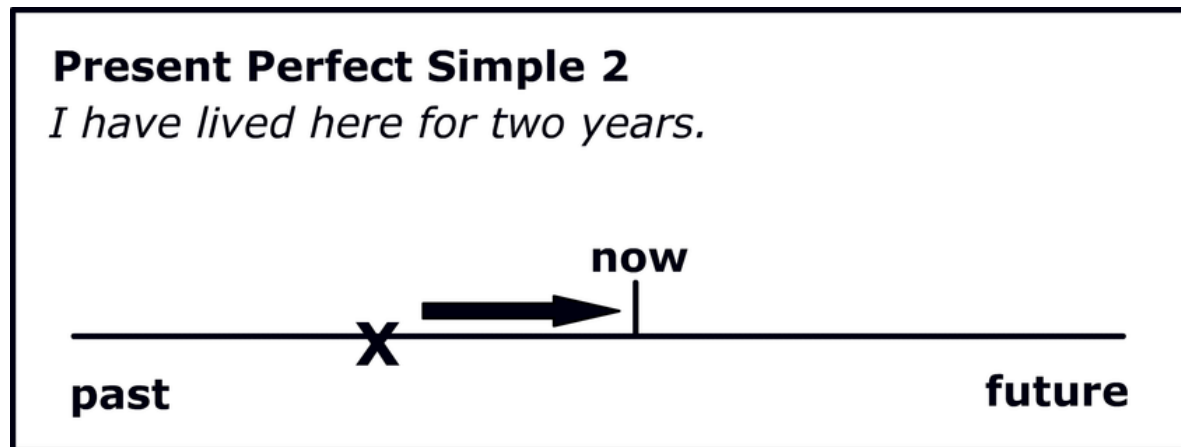
- Regelmatig werkwoord: stam + ed
- Onregelmatig werkwoord: 2<sup>e</sup> rijtje!

# GRAMMAR – PAST SIMPLE

- I lived abroad for ten years.
  - They always enjoyed visiting their friends.
  - I **met** my wife in 1983.
  - We **went** to Spain for our holidays.
- 
1. The young man \_\_\_\_\_ (take) out his wallet and \_\_\_\_\_ (pay) the bill.
  2. Yesterday, I \_\_\_\_\_ (arrive) in Geneva.
  3. She \_\_\_\_\_ (be) a teacher when she was younger.

# GRAMMAR – PRESENT PERFECT

- In verleden begonnen, nog aan de gang; gebeurtenissen waarvan je resultaat nog merkt
- Signaalwoorden! Never, since, already (p/ 139)



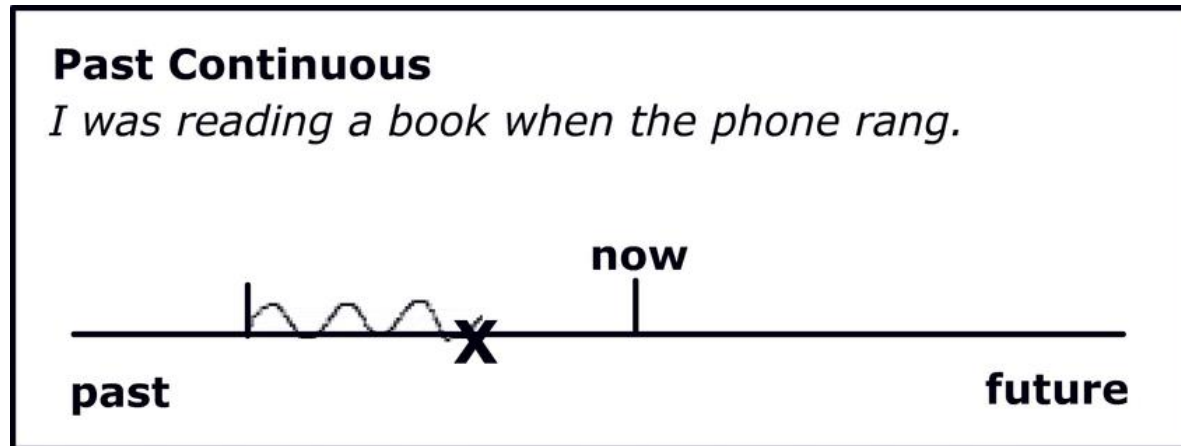
- **Have/has** + **voltooid deelwoord** (stam+ed/3<sup>e</sup> rijtje)

# GRAMMAR – PRESENT PERFECT

- She **has lived** here all her life.
  - They **have written** three letters already.
  - He **has finished** his homework.
  - We **have been** to Canada.
- 
1. I \_\_\_\_\_ (study) French, so I can speak it very well.
  2. We \_\_\_\_\_ (know) David for ten years.
  3. He \_\_\_\_\_ (lose) his keys.

# GRAMMAR – PAST CONTINUOUS

- In het verleden een tijdje aan de gang geweest



- **Was/were** + **hele werkwoord** + **ing**

# GRAMMAR – PAST CONTINUOUS

- We **were watching** TV when Lisa called.
  - When the phone rang, she **was writing** a letter.
  - While John **was sleeping** last night, someone stole his car.
  - Sammy **was waiting** for us when we got off the plane.
- 
1. Julie \_\_\_\_\_ (sleep) at three o'clock.
  2. Mr Black \_\_\_\_\_ (work) when the murder happened.
  3. I \_\_\_\_\_ (listen) to music while I was cooking yesterday.
