▪ Je kunt if-zinnen voor drie dingen gebruiken:

1. Feiten
2. Als je (bijna) zeker weet dat iets gaat gebeuren
3. Als je (bijna) zeker weet dat iets niet gaat gebeuren

# IF-SENTENCES - FEITEN

- **If** + **present simple** + **present simple**
- **If** you **are** late, you **get** detention.
- **If** you **kill** someone, you **go** to jail.

# IF-SENTENCES – ALS IETS ZEKER GAAT GEBEUREN

- **If** + **present simple** + **will** + **hele werkwoord**
- **If** you **bring** me home tonight I **will treat** you to a milkshake.
- **If** he **finishes** his homework he **will pass** his test.

# IF-SENTENCES – ALS IETS ZEKER (NIET) GAAT GEBEUREN

- **If** + **past simple** + **would** + **hele werkwoord**
- **If** he **finished** his homework this morning, he **would pass** the test.
- **If** my sister **loved** me, she **would bring** me a treat.

# IF-SENTENCES

1. If Jonathan \_\_\_\_\_ that path over there, he \_\_\_\_\_ at his uncle's house. (follow; arrive)
2. If it \_\_\_\_\_ tomorrow, I \_\_\_\_\_ at home. (rain; stay)
3. If you \_\_\_\_\_ nice to her, she \_\_\_\_\_ nice to you. (be; be)
4. If we \_\_\_\_\_ in Norway, my mother \_\_\_\_\_ us. (live; miss)
