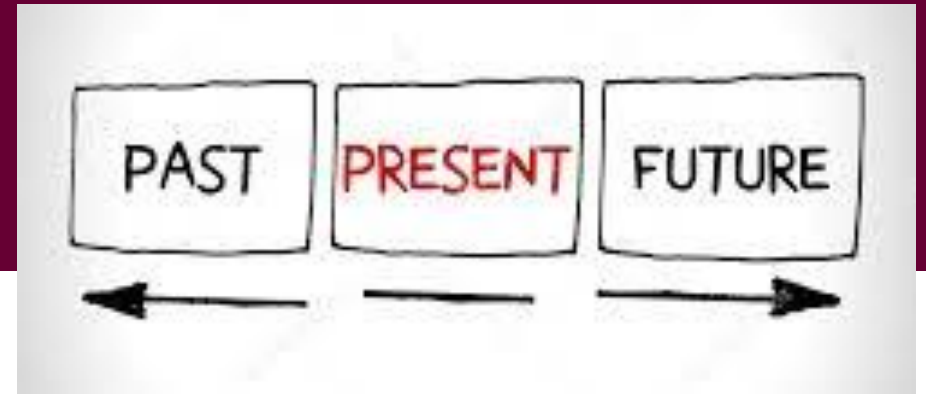

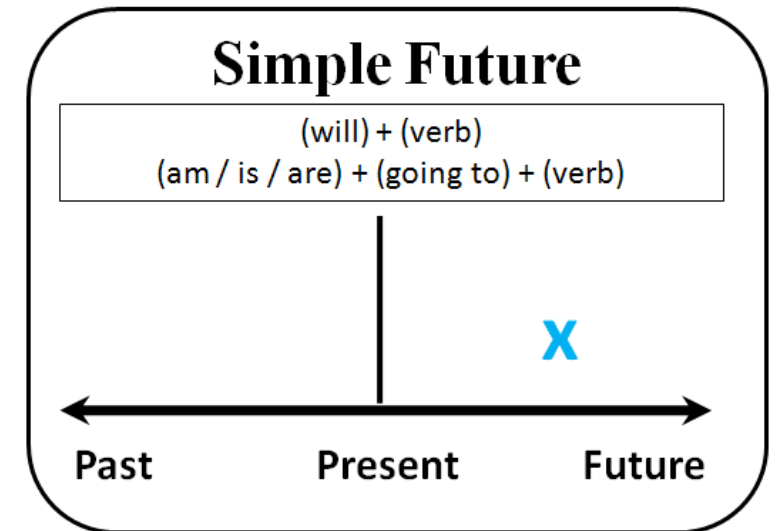

1. iets in de toekomst van plan

I **am going to see** my aunt tomorrow.

2. Voorspelling (WEL BEWIJS)

They **are going to cook** tonight.

Am/is/are + going to + hele werkwoord
