In	Dagdeel	I usually watch tv in the evening
	Maanden	My birthday is in April
	Seizoenen	It gets really cold in winter
	Jaren	He graduated in 2004
On	Dagen	They have a dentist appointment on Tuesday
	Datums	The holidays start on the 5th of February
	Feestdagen	Our family gets together on Christmas day
At	Tijd	Let's meet at 5 p.m.
	Avond	My father has to work at night
	Het weekend	My parents don't work at the weekend
	Vieringen	I stay with my family at Christmas
Before	Voor, voordat	Finish your homework before you meet up with friends
After	Na, nadat	You can go out after you do the dishes
During	Tijdens	All shops will be closed during the lockdown.
Until	Tot, totdat	I will wait for you until 11 o'clock * <i>Let op! 1 L</i>
From.....to	Van...tot	She works from eight to four

Advanced

When we say **last**, **next**, **every**, **this** we do not also use **at**, **in**, **on**.

- I went to London **last** June. (**not** in last June)
- He's coming back **next** Tuesday. (**not** on next Tuesday)
- I go home **every** Easter. (**not** at every Easter)
- We'll call you **this** evening. (**not** in this evening)
