

Present Simple

Shit Rule

she - he - it = werkwoord + **s**

Present Simple

o Rule: he / she / it → verb + s

Example:

I **walk** to school every day.

You **walk** to school every day.

He **walks** to school every day.

She **walks** to school every day.

It **walks** to school every day.

We walk to school every day.

You walk to school every day.

They walk to school every day.



Present Simple: smile

I often smile.
You often smile.

He often smiles.
She often smiles.
It often smiles.

We often smile.
You often smile.
They often smile.



Present Simple: study^y

I study English.

You study English.

He stud**ies** English.

Y → **IES**

She stud**ies** English.

Y → **IES**

It stud**ies** English.

Y → **IES**

We study English.

You study English.

They study English.



Present Simple: kiss



I kiss my sweetheart.
You kiss your sweetheart.

He kiss**es** his sweetheart.
She kiss**es** her sweetheart.
It kiss**es** its sweetheart.

kiss → kiss**es**

kiss → kiss**es**

kiss → kiss**es**

We kiss our sweetheart.
You kiss your sweetheart.
They kiss their sweetheart.

Present Simple: go

I go to school by bus.
You go school by bus.

He go**es** school by bus. go → go**es**
She go**es** school by bus. go → go**es**
It go**es** school by bus. go → go**es**

We go school by bus.
You go school by bus.
They go school by bus.



Present Simple

- o Verb + **s** → he / she / it walks
- o Study + **s** → he / she / it studies
- o Kiss + **s** → He / she / it kisses
- o Go + **s** → He / she / it goes
