she – he – it = werkwoord + s

Present Simple

Example:

l	walk	to school every day.
You	walk	to school every day.
He	walks	to school every day.
She	walks	to school every day.
It	walks	to school every day.
We	walk	to school every day.
You	walk	to school every day.
They	walk	to school every day.



Present Simple: smile

I often smile. You often smile.

He often smiles. She often smiles. It often smiles.

We often smile. You often smile. They often smile.



Present Simple: study

I study English. You study English.

He stud**ies** English. She studies English. $Y \rightarrow IES$ It studies English.

 $Y \rightarrow IES$ $Y \rightarrow IES$

We study English. You study English. They study English.



Present Simple: kiss

I kiss my sweetheart. You kiss your sweetheart.

He kiss**es** his sweetheart. She kiss**es** her sweetheart. It kiss**es** its sweetheart.

We kiss our sweetheart. You kiss your sweetheart. They kiss their sweetheart. $kiss \rightarrow kisses$ $kiss \rightarrow kisses$ $kiss \rightarrow kisses$

Present Simple: go

I go to school by bus. You go school by bus.

He goes school by bus. She goes school by bus. It goes school by bus. go → goesgo → goesgo → goes

We go school by bus. You go school by bus. They go school by bus.



Present Simple

 $oldsymbol{O}$ Study + s → he / she / it studies

 \circ Kiss + s \rightarrow He / she / it kisses

O Go + s \rightarrow He / she / it goes
