Plural Nouns

A noun that describes only one thing is a **singular noun**.

examples: book, dish

A noun that describes more than one thing is a **plural noun**.

examples: books, dishes

Most singular nouns can be made plural by just adding an **s** to the end.

Nouns ending in x, z, s, sh and ch form the plural by adding an **es** to the end.



Singular: I have a colorful dish.



Pural: I have lots of colorful dishes.
