To be + going to + ww

Of

Shall/will + hele ww

To be + going to + ww

Vorm van to be	Going to	werkwoord
I am	going to	sleep
You are	going to	eat
He is	going to	dance
She is	going to	murder
We are	going to	pass

I am going to work tomorrow.
She is going to murder her husband tonight.
The dog is going to eat that food.

TO BE GOING TO gebruik je als je zeker bent dat iets gaat gebeuren in de toekomst.

We are going to be at the party.
We are going to finish this test
She is going to go home.
Look at those clouds, it's going to rain!

Remember to use: **to be + going to + verb**

Mary is going to go to the supermarket.

Is + going to + go

Morty computer games.

Sarah her novels.

Bob his bike.

Pete and Janet at a restaurant.

Jack a race.

Carol and John married.

shall / will

YOU SHALL NOT PASS



shall en will gebruik je als iets in de toekomst gaat gebeuren, maar het kan nog veranderen.

I will **go** to the cinema
I will **leave** at 9

VORM = will/shall + **hele ww**

Om toekomst aan te geven gebruik je meestal WILL

Je gebruikt SHALL bij vragen waarin 'I' en 'we' staat:

Shall I leave?

Shall we go?

Will we go? -> je weet zelf niet zeker of je zal gaan.
Shall we go? -> je vraagt aan iemand of jullie zullen gaan: "zullen we gaan?"

Shall is ook ouderwets en "slechterik-taal"

I shall not allow you to go!

You shall not pass!

I shall destroy you, mr Bond!
