Climate

The weather conditions prevailing in an area in general or over a long period.

Homo Sapiens

the primate species to which modern humans belong; humans regarded as a species.

Biodiversity

the variety of plant and animal life in the world or in a particular habitat, a high level of which is usually considered to be important and desirable.

Preventable (adj)

able to be prevented or avoided.

Gas emission

the release of gas it into the atmosphere.

Polution

the presence in or introduction into the environment of a substance which has harmful or poisonous effects.

Green House effect

the trapping of the sun's warmth in a planet's lower atmosphere

Apocalypse

the complete final destruction of the world

Veganism

the practice of abstaining from the use of animal products, particularly in diet.

Uncharted Territory

exploration of a new area.

Overpopulation

the condition of being populated with excessively large numbers.
