Zeg dat je inderdaad ook het gevoel hebt dat je moet overgeven.

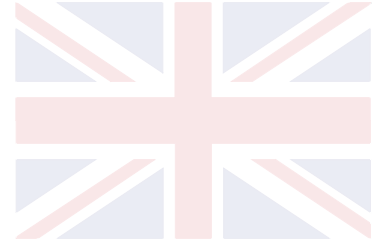
I think it is the flu. Take an aspirin every 6 hours to lower your fever.
